WONGS' BOOK GRANT APPLICATION FOR 2014/15

Since 1990, the Wongs' Association of Ontario has been offering academic grants to students enrolled in a full-time university or college program to help cover the costs of textbooks or school supplies. This award is among many other academic awards designed to encourage our members to become involved and active in activities sponsored by the Wongs' Youth Organization (WYO) and the Wongs' Association of Ontario.

Instructions

1. Read the Eligibility Guidelines in order to determine your eligibility for the Book Grant.
2. Complete all areas of the application form, sign it and attach proof of tuition payment.
3. Bring/send completed application to the Wongs' Association (Our office hours are Mon to Sun, 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.) or email to wongsyouth@gmail.com. **Deadline for applications is November 30, 2014;** late applications will not be accepted.

Eligibility Guidelines

The following guidelines must be satisfied in order to qualify for the Wongs' Book Grant:

- Student must be a member of the Wongs' Association in good standing (fees paid and not in arrears). However, if the student is under 18 years old, one of the parents must be a member of the Wongs' Ass'n in good standing instead.
- A photocopy of university /college tuition payment must be submitted to prove full-time enrolment.
- Student must satisfy the participation requirements (see participation requirements below) within a twelve (12) month period preceding the application deadline and describe them in the completed application.
- Student must pick up grant at the Wongs' Association or at a designated WYO event; i.e. Christmas Party on Dec 15.

Please note that participation credits earned for use towards the Wongs' Book Grant cannot be used again to qualify for other Wongs' academic awards.
