WONGS' SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR 2022/2023

The Wongs' Association of Ontario student graduation scholarships and high school grade awards are exclusive benefits for members of the Wongs' Association. These academic awards recognize scholastic achievement and encourage participation in the various youth activities conducted by the Wongs' Youth Organization (WYO). There are three types of graduation scholarships: Elementary School (graduate from Grade 8), High School (graduate from Grade 12), and University/College. There are also three different high school grade awards: Grade 9, Grade 10, and Grade 11.

Instructions

1. Read the Eligibility Guidelines in order to determine your eligibility for the scholarship or high school grade award.
2. Complete all areas of the application form, sign it and attach a copy of all required documents.
3. Bring completed application to the Wongs' Association (Our office hours are Mon. to Sun., 1 p.m. - 5 p.m.) or email them to wongsyouth@gmail.com. We will not accept faxing or mailing of applications. The deadline for applications is July 31, 2023. We will send an email notice to confirm the status of your application.

Eligibility Guidelines

The following guidelines must be satisfied in order to qualify for the Wongs' graduation scholarship or high school award:

- Student must be a member of the Wongs' Association in good standing (fees paid and not in arrears). However, if the student is under 18 years old, a parent must be a member of the Wongs' Association in good standing instead.
- A photocopy of a university degree, college diploma, Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) or elementary school certificate (Grade 8 certificate) must be submitted with the application form (or a photocopy of a final report card showing a minimum grade average of 80% must be submitted for the high school grade award.)
- Student must satisfy the participation requirements (see participation requirements below) within a twelve (12) month period preceding the application deadline and describe them in the completed application.
- Student must pick up their award at the Wongs' Association or at a designated WYO event.

Please note that participation credits earned for use towards the Wongs' graduation scholarships will not count towards Community Service High School Graduation Requirements and cannot be used again for other Wongs' academic awards.
